TERMS OF USE

IN TERMS OF SECTION 11 OF THE ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND TRANSACTIONS (ECT) ACT 25 OF 2002 AND THE COMMON LAW OF CONTRACT, THESE TERMS OF USE ARE VALID, BINDING AND ENFORCEABLE AGAINST ALL PERSONS THAT ACCESS THE NEWSTRACK ONLINE WEBSITE OR USE THE SERVICE THROUGH THE NEWSTRACK ONLINE WEBSITE OR ANY PART THEREOF.

IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS OF USE YOU MUST LEAVE THE WEBSITE(S) IMMEDIATELY AS FURTHER USE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BIND YOU TO THESE TERMS OF USE.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- a) "Newstrack Online" means Newstrack Online (PTY) LTD, registration number 2006/038633/07 of The Firs, Craddock Ave, Rosebank, Johannesburg, Gauteng, South Africa, 2196.
- b) "the Service" means the online news monitoring service offered by Newstrack Online to Subscribers;
- c) "Service Agreement" means an agreement concluded between Newstrack Online and Subscribers for provision of the Service;
- d) "Subscribers" means parties who concluded a Service Agreement with Newstrack Online for the monitoring of online news:
- e) "the Website" means the Newstrack Online website, Newsletter, Application and RSS feeds, including the Service available on and through the aforementioned and any page, part or element thereof;
- f) "User" means any person who enters or uses the Website;
- g) "Terms of Use" mean the terms and conditions on which we make the Website available;
- h) References herein to the singular includes the plural and vice versa; and
- i) Hyperlinks herein to legal documents should be deemed part of these Terms of Use in terms of section 11(3) of the ECT Act. The fact that some or all of the hyperlinks may, from time to time, be nonoperational, shall not affect the validity and interpretation of these Terms of Use.

1. GENERAL

Newstrack Online is an online news monitoring service available to Subscribers.

2. ALLOWED USE AND LICENSE

- 2.1 Newstrack Online licenses the User to view, download, and print the content of the Website and / or use the Service provided that such use is for private, personal, educational, and/or non-commercial purposes only.
- 2.2 Content from the Website and the Service may not be used or exploited by Users for any commercial and non-private purposes without the prior written consent of Newstrack Online.
- 2.3 Users may only access, browse and use the Website and Service for legitimate personal or commercial purposes and may not use the Website or any Newstrack Online services and/or products for:
 - 2.3.1 Harmful purposes;
 - 2.3.2 Illegal purposes;
 - 2.3.3 Disclosing, sharing or publishing material that may be offensive, defamatory, regulated, copyrighted, incorrect, untrue, prohibited, infringing or damaging to any person; and/or

- 2.3.4 The creation, storage and sending of unsolicited commercial communications.
- 2.4 The caching of the Website shall only be allowed if:
 - 2.4.1 The purpose of the caching is to make the onward transmission of the content from the Website more efficient;
 - 2.4.2 The cached content is not modified in any manner whatsoever;
 - 2.4.3 The cached content is updated at least every 12 (twelve) hours; and
 - 2.4.4 The cached content is removed or updated when so required by Newstrack Online.
- 2.5 If any User uses content from the Website or the Service in breach of the provisions detailed herein:
 - 2.5.1 Newstrack Online reserves the right to claim damages from the User;
 - 2.5.2 Newstrack Online reserves the right to institute criminal proceedings against the User; and
 - 2.5.3 Newstrack Online shall not be liable, in any manner whatsoever, for any damage, loss or liability that resulted from the use of such content by the User or any third party who obtained any content from the User.
- 2.6 Hyperlinks to the Website from any other source shall be directed at the home page of the Website. Links beyond the Newstrack Online home page may only be used with Newstrack Online's prior written consent.

3.1 All intellectual property on the Website, including but not limited to content, trademarks (or any confusingly similar trademarks), trade names, logos, pictures, video, downloads, domain names, patents, design elements, software, source code, meta tags, databases, text, graphics, icons and hyperlinks are the property of or licensed to Newstrack Online and as such, are protected from infringement by domestic and international legislation and treaties. Subject to the rights licensed to the User in section 2, all other rights to intellectual property on the Website are expressly reserved.

- 3.2 No person shall amend, copy, use, decompile and / or reverse engineer the source code of the Website.
- 3.3 No person may use logos, icons, or trademarks from the Website as hyperlinks or other purposes without Newstrack Online's prior written consent.

- Any failure by Newstrack Online to exercise or enforce any right or provision shall in no way constitute a waiver of such right or provision.
- 12.3 In the event that any term or condition detailed herein is found unenforceable or invalid for any reason, such term(s) or condition(s) shall be severable from the remaining Terms of Use. The remaining Terms of Use shall remain enforceable and applicable.

13. AGREEMENT IN TERMS OF SECTION 21 OF THE ECT ACT

The User and Newstrack Online agree that:

- the User shall be bound to these term and conditions and such agreement is concluded in Pretoria (South Africa) at the time the User enters the Website for the first time;
- data messages (as defined in the ECT Act) addressed by the User to Newstrack Online shall only be deemed to have been received if and when responded to;
- data messages (as defined in the ECT Act) addressed to the User by Newstrack Online shall be deemed to be received by the User as detailed in section 23(b) of the ECT Act;
- data messages (as defined in the ECT Act) addressed by the User to Newstrack Online shall be deemed to have been created and sent by the User from within the geographical boundaries of South Africa;
- electronic signatures, encryption and/or authentication is not required for valid electronic communications between the User and the Newstrack Online; and
- the User agrees and warrants that data messages that are sent to Newstrack Online from a computer, IP address or mobile device normally used by or owned by the User, was sent and/or authorised by the User personally.

14. APPLICABLE AND GOVERNING LAW

The Newstrack Online website is hosted, controlled and operated from the Republic of South Africa and therefore, subject to clause 5 the South African law enforced by the South African courts governs the use or inability to use the Website, its content, services, products and these Terms of Use.

Newstrack Online shall not be liable for costs incurred by Users to obtain professional advice relating to these Terms of Use.
